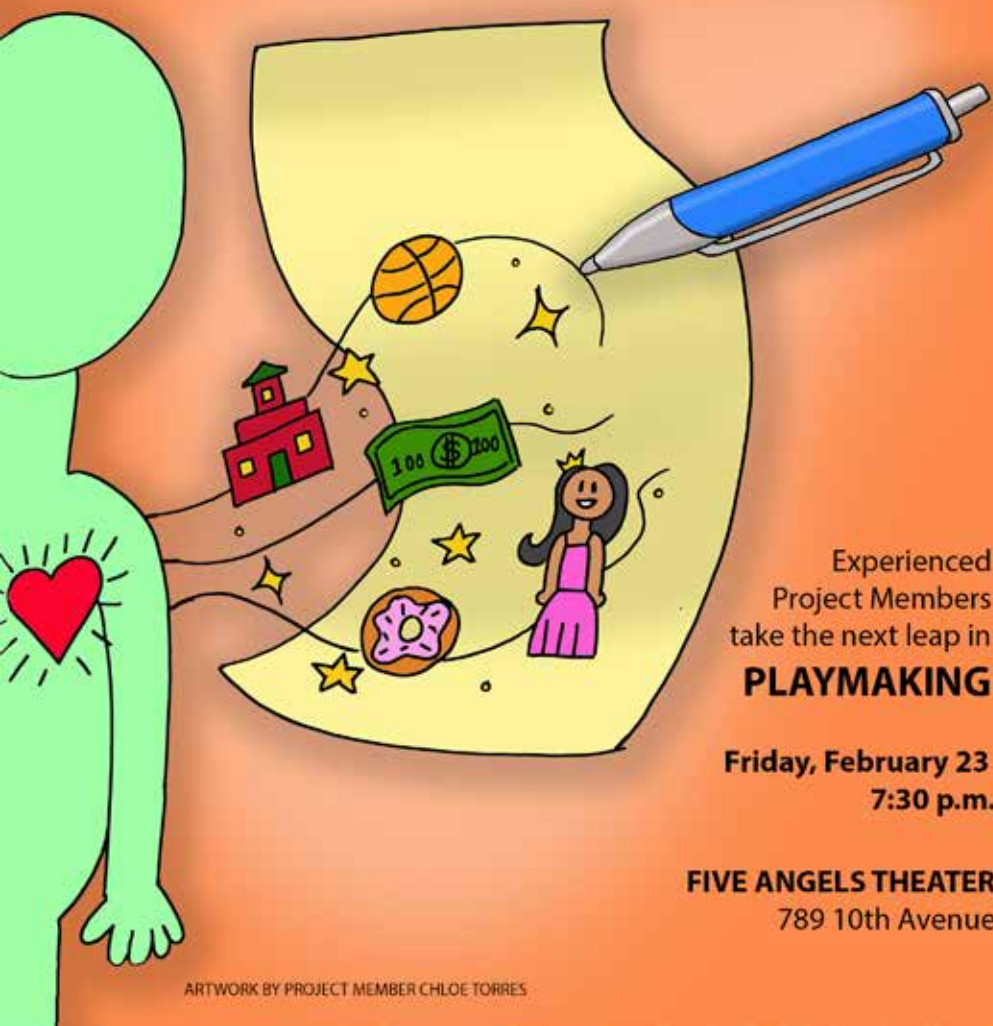

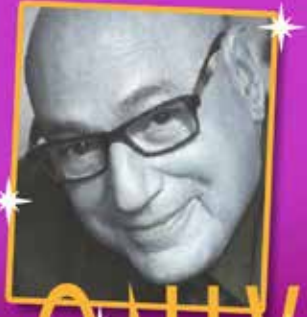

**Giovanni Benedicto** (*Playwright*) joined the Project in the fall of 2021 with his debut play *RANDOM FRIENDS*, dramaturgy & direction by Sean Kenealy, starring Stephanie Jean Lane and Mitchell Winter, as part of *PIECE OF CAKE, The Slice of Life Plays*. Giovanni made his acting debut opposite Alex J. Gould in Helen Cespedes' *THE MOST AMAZING SHOW ON EARTH*, as a part of *ARE WE THERE YET, The Location Plays*, our August 2022 One-on-Ones. He can be heard on the *PROJcast* Episode 39 "The Writers of *PIECE OF CAKE, The Slice of Life Plays*."
