





Young people participated in a playwriting course taught by Kat Almirañez and adapted for the Project by Daniel Judah Sklar from his book Playmaking: Children Writing and Performing Their Own Plays. At the end of the course, each child was matched with two actors and a dramaturg/director who guided him or her through the writing of a play during a weekend retreat in the country. For this round, we journeyed to the home of Kimiye Corwin, Jesse Liebman, and their daughters Ruby and Maxine in Roxbury, Connecticut.


